2012 SUMMER Sign-up for FALL SPORTS

sign-up's for FALL Sports will be held at Willink Middle School August 8 and 9 from 6-8:45 pm; All schools/All Levels

PHYSICAL EXAMS: Physicals dated August 1, 2011 and later qualify as current for the fall sports season. **NO EXTENSIONS OF PHYSICALS ARE ACCEPTED.**

- A physical must be on file in the Health Office by June 11th (either private MD or School sports physical).
- OR
- Bring a copy of your current physical from your private MD with you when you sign up in August.

MEDICATIONS: If you require emergency medication (inhaler, epi-pen, glucagons) you **MUST** have current self-carry MD orders on file in the Health Office. **Orders must be renewed every school year.**

FORMS: Complete the Seasonal Sports Sign-up Form; it must be signed by parent/guardian **AND** student **on or after JULY 12, 2012.** Submit the completed form during the Seasonal Sports Sign-up in August.

- Forms may be turned in on or after 7/14/12. Please check forms carefully. Incomplete forms will not be processed.
- Any sports restrictions, immunizations and emergency self-carry medication questions must be resolved before the form can be signed and the student is able to play.
- Submit all *missing documentation (italics above)* to your Health Office, **OR** bring it with you when you come during the scheduled Sign-up times.

Re-Enrollment & Admissions

Please be sure to complete your re-enrollment as soon as possible. We greatly appreciate your prompt attention to re-enrollment!!

Remember that WCS gives a tuition incentive of \$300 for recruiting new families. These scholarships are available to the first family whose recommendation causes a new family to enroll and remain in the school for 6 months or more.

Tour Days - Any day is a "tour day" at WCS. Mr. Keith Bell will set his schedule to accommodate any prospective family. A tour is a great way for prospective parents to see the school in action!

Shadowing - The best way for a prospective student to see what WCS is like is to spend a day at the school "shadowing". Shadowers follow a current student around for the day visiting each class, observing the teachers and getting an opportunity to connect with their peers.

We thank the Lord for each of the families at WCS. There are few gifts you can give your children that have as positive and long-lasting benefits as placing them in a school where God's Word is taught and lived out before them through the faculty and staff.

WHERE TO GET SEASONAL SPORTS SIGN-UP FORMS:

Athletes should pick up forms during the month of June (before school ends!) and check on their Physical Exam date **AND** restriction status. Bring the completed form and any physicals, med orders and clearances with you to the Seasonal Sports Sign-up times which is @ the Willink Middle School Main Corridor. Enter North Doors @ rear of building:

- AUGUST 8, 2012 (Wednesday) 6PM-9PM (Doors close at 8:45)
- AUGUST 9, 2012 (Thursday) 6PM-9PM (Doors close 8:45)

ALL FORMS MUST BE SUBMITTED BY (FRI) AUG 17, 2012, 12:00 NOON

SEASONAL SPORTS FORMS MUST BE SIGNED BY THE SCHOOL NURSE BEFORE THE FIRST PRACTICE!!!

You and your child may receive all immunizations (no cost for students) at: Monroe County Health Department, 111 Westfall Road, Rochester, NY 14692

Immunization Clinic (phone: 753-5150) Walk-in clinic is Wed afternoons 12:00-7:00PM, last check-in 6:30. Student should have immunization record with him/her. Students enrolled in Child Health Plus, or Medicaid must bring insurance card.

The Webster Central School District physician strongly recommends current tetanus for participation in sports. Tetanus is good for 10 years. Your child's primary care provider may administer tetanus. Please provide written documentation of immunization to the Health Office if your child receives any immunizations.
